





Dlearn Mission

Dlearn concept









Disconnected, discouraged, disenabled? Let's code!



In particular, the meeting was focused on enhancing access and quality of information and communication technologies (ICT).

Digital Apprenticeship

← Dlearn was invited by the DG Connect, in Brussels, to attend a working group to discuss about the "Digital Opportunity" which is a pilot project that European Commission intends to launch in the autumn 2017. It promotes cross-border traineeships in European companies for students and recent graduates, with the aim of improving their digital skills. The traineeships will start in the academic year 2018/2019, may have duration of up to five months and must be carried out without interruption.
